From South: Take I-65 North and take Exit 94. Turn LEFT at the exit onto Highway 62 (Mulberry Street)

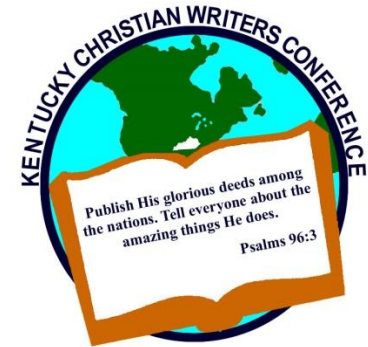
